Why Portuguese?

★ Portuguese is currently the 7th most spoken language in the world. Also, the rapid growth of the Brazilian economy (now the 6th largest worldwide) is causing a surge in the demand for Portuguese speakers. In response to this need, UGA is offering the nation's first and only Portuguese Flagship Program, to enhance its pre-existing program and increase the number of UGA students who graduate with a high level of proficiency in the language.

Internationalize your degree... Professionalize your Portuguese...

★ Intended for highly motivated undergraduates seeking to internationalize their UGA education, the program will consist of intensive language instruction, one-on-one tutorials, skype partners in Brazil, and other innovative curriculum. Flagship students will also spend a year in Brazil where they will reach professional-level Portuguese proficiency through language and content courses, as well as a semester long internship in a field related to their area of study.

UGA is partnering with São Paulo State University (UNESP) for the overseas portion of the program. The Flagship model is designed so that students from as many majors as possible will be able to complete their degree on time, while also fulfilling the requirements of a Language Flagship Certificate.

Who can apply?

★ The Program will admit undergraduate students of all majors who demonstrate a unique commitment to achieving a high level of proficiency in Portuguese and devoting a year to study abroad in Brazil, for which scholarships may be available.

Flagship entrance requirements:

- ✓ Full-time undergraduate admitted to UGA
- ✓ Commitment to working towards a Superior level of Portuguese (ACTFL tested) upon completion of program
- ✓ Commitment to 1 year study abroad in Brazil
- ✓ U.S. citizen or permanent resident, to be eligible for possible federal funding
